PRECIOUS MEETING GUIDELINE

1] Begin the Meeting: -

- □ <u>Always vary</u> how you start each meeting so that it doesn't become one of those stale meetings! Keep beginnings as brief as possible!

 Remember this is not a sermon or workshop.
- □ In your introductory comments, <u>take some time to praise</u> the different precious members of your group for things you have noticed your group for. Things you have noticed in their assigned jobs or ministries during that month!

Encourage some chatting:-

A team that connects personally as well as professionally or in ministry will be the most successful team.

Download praise on your team members during your meetings:-

- □ Affirm them when they use their spiritual gifts, natural skills and even when they step out of their comfort zones during their services.
- □It's good to keep the meeting moving, but be sensitive and flexible also for members who might have a burning issue at heart to discuss.
- □Where there's a need for **corrections make it a private meeting**!

3] GROUP DEVOTIONAL SEGMENT:

Use a devotional thought as guided below):

Read, share and discuss the following topics & scriptures:

- □ Joshua's vision and faith (Joshua 1:1-11)
- □ Eli's laxness (1 Samuel 2:12=36)
- □ David's respect for other's spiritual authority (1 Samuel 24)
- □ David's sensitivity to others: [1Chronicles 10v15-19]
- □ David attracted the right followers [1Chronicles 12v1-40]
- □ Men who understood the times [1Chronicles 12v32] [Esther 1v13]
- □ Supporting & acting as ONE man, a united team in action: [1 Chronicles 12:38]
- □ Nathan's honesty (2 Samuel 12:1-4)
- □ Solomon's asking God for wisdom to lead his people (1 Kings 3)
- □ Jesus' servant leadership (John 13:1-17)
- □ Paul compassion and love for those he served (Acts 20:13-38)
- □ Loving one another: [Romans 12v9-11; Romans 13v7-9]
- □ Forgiving one another. [Colossians 3v13]
- □ Serving one another. [John 13v11-13]

[These 24 given topics should be used by your group monthly/bi-weekly for growth.]





4] **AFTER DEVOTION**:

- □ Ask each Precious woman member a few personal questions about:-
- □ Invite each member to:Briefly tell the others something she learned from the previous scriptures shared!
- □ A good way to foster your relationship and bonding of the group!



5] GROUP PRAYER SEGMENT:

Lead Prayer focusing on:-

- □ Pray for the guidance and direction of the Holy Spirit.
- □ Pray for the Global work of your ministry- JHM Global.
- □ The spirit of sisterhood and group bonding.
- □ Growth of your group.
- □ Wisdom for leadership
- □ Encouragement for the challenges of ministry.
- □ Patience for issues involving difficult people.
- □ Praise for being apart of ministry and serving God.
- □ Thanksgiving for the team God has put together.
- $\hfill\Box$ God's guidance for directing souls and ministries.
- □ Conflict resolution.
- □ Compassion and a shepherds heart!
- □ Issue of need and God's provision.

□ Prayer for your nation and national leadership
□ Other prayer points as the Spirit directs.

SEVEN PILLARS OF THE PRECIOUS WOMAN GROUPS

1. PRAYER FOR FAMILIES & COMMUNITY

This include intercessory prayers for: Families Community Nations Fellow sisters

2. DEVOTION & FELLOWSHIP

Devotional studies and fellowship in the presence of the Lord together as sisters under God, in one Spirit.

3. PRECIOUS WALK

<u>Empowerment</u>: Learning to walk in your **Value-+ Identity + Purpose** as a woman of God aspiring to be a leader in her home, church, community & nation.

4. PRECIOUS LIFESTYLE

Learning to live your life a precious woman, living a precious & healthy lifestyle whilst connecting with other sisters, helping one another, and supporting each other as a precious band of sisters

5. PRECIOUS MOMENTS - Supporting One Another!

Special tea/coffee gathering where sisters meet to sip beverages, eat together, develop special bonding, celebrate each other and become a strong force within society with the help of the Holy Spirit. The place to open up and share things happening in your life, to receive support from each other through sharing your experience and what you're going through.

6. GALILEAN BREAKFAST-ANNUAL EVENT
