What is the precious woman group?

The precious woman group is an initiative of the Jannet Hopewell Ministries where women are encouraged to come together, bound by our commonality of purpose which is to help each other and to help our sisters in need in our own community and across the world. Our service to God is the highest ideal that binds us together as a true band of sisters in Christ who are on a mission to transform the world for good. As a practice we gather together frequently with like minded women for a joyful period of socialising, praying for others, praying for each other and for the world, sharing encouraging Gospel messages and/or reviewing a good book together. We break bread by sharing a simple meal together with our signature cups of tea, coffee or fresh juice on every occasion.
We are women on a mission!

Whilst the **Precious Woman Group** may have the appearance of a social group with friends gathering together to have a good time, It is also important to be focused on the **REAL PURPOSE** which mainly is:

To fellowship together through Christ Jesus.

To join forces to help other women & sisters rise out of their poor circumstances and become over comers also.

Grow together stronger in your natural & spiritual walk in Christ.

Become a support structure to one another in good & bad times.

To form a community for life and engage in building a Kingdom bond.



What is the core purpose of the precious woman group?

To support each other & be there for one another.

To support our sisters who are in need across the world.

To support women & their children by standing up for justice, fairness and equality.

To impact our neighbourhood, communities and the world in simple ways.

To become a force for change in the world by taking a stand to do something for those in need & those living in poverty.

To become a voice for the voiceless and an action force to improve the lives of our sisters across the world.



What are the unique traits/characters of the precious woman groups?

- We are called to make a difference and to be the difference.
- We meet regularly & fellowship together.
- We pray for each other & for our families constantly.
- We encourage one another in Christ.
- We seek to form a community of women, bonding in Christ.
- We are always there for one another, in all circumstances, good & bad.
- We support one another in every God given way possible.
- We build each other up, morally and spiritually.
- We stand strong together.
- We break bread regularly and share in love feasts & tea parties together.
- We mentor one another in love and in Christ.
- We watch out for each other & are willing to correct one another in love.
- We give each other permission to get to know one another better.

What are our qualities?

- We are prayer warriors. [James 5v16-17].
- We are to be true and honest with one another.
- We are committed to friendship in Christ for life not just for a season.
- Openness, honesty of intent & purpose and transparency must exist in us.
- We are willing to LOVE one another and to walk in LOVE. [John 15v15-16]

What is the social signature of the precious woman group at our gatherings?

Praying together.

Listening to & encouraging one another.

Sharing a simple meal whenever together/possible.

Sharing our signature cups of tea, coffee and/or juices.

Studying the Bible as often as possible, regularly.



What are the values of the precious woman group?

Be engaged in charitable activities that benefits our sisters & their children worldwide who are disadvantaged & destitute.

Help all our all sisters, heal the broken, build up the weak & save souls!

What are the activities of the precious woman groups?

There are so many activities of the precious groups. Some are listed below:

1. Participate/support the PWG webinars, seminars and conferences for precious women annually.
2. Fundraise for local as well as international humanitarian projects that benefits disadvantaged women & children.
3. Undertake the precious Walk & Renew Walk courses together.
4. Send in updates, pictures, videos and reports of your local/international activities.
5. Organise your own local women conference or events with organisational help from mission HQ.
6. Plan, host & organise **Galilean Breakfast** every Easter Monday with family &

friends - See John 21v1-21.

7. Celebrate Christmas, Easter & Thanksgiving with your PWG friends and advance the cause of supporting the poor at the same time.

8. Be pro-active in engaging in the campaigns against sex trafficking, forced prostitution and domestic violence, as two women are killed every week in the United Kingdom alone and hundreds more are killed regularly all over the world.

What are the rules/terms of the precious woman group?

Here are the things you/we must not do at all:

A true band of sisters will not hurt one another, gossip, be malicious to the other or walk in unforgiveness. [1 Timothy 5v13]

A true band of sisters will not seek to hate or hurt one another.

A true band of sisters NEVER let each other down. [Titus 2v9]

True band of sisters are NOT selfish or self seeking.

True band of sisters do not envy their other sisters and are not jealous at all.

True band of sisters will not exploit another sister or anyone else.

A true band of sisters do not fold their arms whilst other sisters are suffering all around the world.

A true sister will not use the PWG for self promotion and for personal profit at the expense of the group/mission.

True band of sisters always walk in LOVE!

True band of sisters don't break faith with one another!

Honesty and integrity are a paramount requirement of a PWG participation.



You may not do the following:

1. Do not violate the terms of the precious woman group as led by Jannet Hopewell Ministries Global.
2. Do not use the group/ministry LOGO except for approved lawful & legal group activities & for promoting a worthy cause.
3. Funds raised for JHM Global causes/campaigns must be reported to JHM Head office who manages the PW Groups.
4. Funds raised for non-JHM causes should still be reported to JHM Head office who manages the PW Groups.
5. Do not enter into debt or financial obligations in the name of the PWG or the Charity. It is unlawful to do so.
6. Discovered case(s) of theft or financial irregularity or pecuniary advantage will be reported to the police.
7. DO NOT bring the PWG or JHM organisation into disrepute.
8. Any violation of the above & other PWG stipulated terms will lead to a termination of your PWG membership & suspension of the group!





There are so many positive activities, initiatives and progressive actions that local PWG's can undertake.

Here are some of them:

- Fundraising for the orphans, orphanages & overseas 'Care For Kids' programs.
- Supporting sisters/women and their children living in poverty and destitution in areas of the world.
- Visiting & supporting others in need within your group's own immediate community.
- Undertake to support the domestic violence campaign at any level of involvement, locally or internationally.
- Support schools assistance programs/educational programs for underprivileged children overseas.
- Fundraise for medical outreach missions to poor villages & towns abroad.
- Helping to bring water wells to poor villages or building community latrines (toilets) that dignifies poor & rural women.

•Participating in funding small micro-finance projects to help a poor woman start a small trade. The list is endless, as such PWG's are encourage to set goals and targets for making impact and not just exist as a social club of women. That defeats the objective and purpose of the precious woman groups.



How to report back your precious woman group activities?

There are several ways to report back your activities to group Headquarters @JHM, such as:

- By emailing reports of your group activities to your group advocate at Mission HQ regularly or as often as possible.
- By making mission HQ aware of your activities and fundraising events/plans.
- By sending your prayer requests to Mission HQ.
- By send/upload your event videos and activities for sharing with the global PWG communities. (Short videos only).
- By sending group meeting photographs and activity photos for sharing with the global PWG community.
- By notifying mission HQ of any positive press reporting of your PWG events & activities.

Here are some of the Frequently Asked Questions:

Who can start a precious woman group & operate it?

Young ladies & women aged 18 and over.
There is no maximum age limit.

How many people are required to start a group?

One woman and a friend or group of friends.

Is there a membership fee to join or start a PWG?

No, membership is free but donations are thankfully received to support our mission work.

Do you have resources for the precious woman group?

Yes, we have so many publications, books, workbooks, journals, devotional & resources such as videos, CD's and other resources to assist your group & daily walk.

Will I be issued with a PWG group certificate when I start my start group?

Yes, but a nominal fee will be charged for the certificate printing & for postage.
